



## *Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch Therapeutic Riding Program Wish List*

- Safe, calm and sound horses: non-cash receipt for donated horses
- Become an Equine Angel and befriend the horse of your choosing!
- Grooming equipment: curry combs - \$5; brushes - \$6; hoof picks - \$3; mane and tail combs - \$5
- Horse fly spray: \$10 for a small bottle
- Lead ropes: cotton, 3/4 to one-inch thick: \$8 - \$10
- Headstalls, leather: \$40+
- Reins--leather, split or roping styles: \$25+
- Horse blankets--medium to large: 70 – 84” in length, with 640D: \$90+
- Helmets, sized medium to large: \$27+
- Wheelbarrow: \$50
- Shovels--not spades: \$20
- Pitchforks: \$20
- Manure forks: \$20
- Manure spreader, 150 Bussel SP
- Saddles: \$200+, depends on if they are new or used
- Halters (medium size): \$18+
- Washed sand for the outdoor arena: \$45-50 a ton (dependent on company's current cost).  
We need around 40 tons. There is an extra \$80 delivery charge.
- Cat food (Barn Cats help with therapy too!): \$14 for 18-20 lb. bags
- Round horse-bale feeders: \$200+
- Feed: \$15 a bag for 50 lbs. of senior equine, which almost all the horses get.  
One bag lasts the herd about three days.
- Saddle racks that fold down onto wall: \$18+
- Cash gifts of any amount
- Supplies to build year-round shelter for the horses:  
wood posts, siding material (tin/wood), and roofing material (tin)
- Supplies to build shade shelters (picnic shelter) for the horses in four locations;  
size 10 x 20 x 12 feet high: wood posts, roofing material (tin)
